**Beginning**

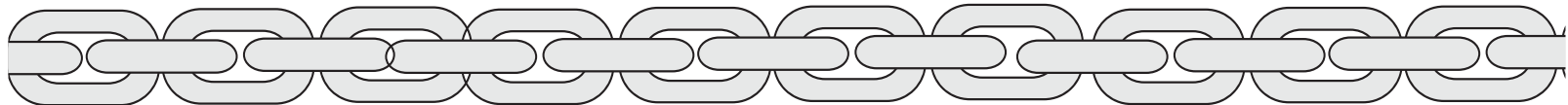
