Tips: Print out the masks on heavy cardstock. If you print on regular paper, glue the mask to some lightweight cardboard or laminate for durability.

If you laminate, cut out the eye holes before you laminate so you don't have to cut a hole through the paper and the lamination.

The easiest option is to put a large craft stick on the side of the mask and the child can hold it on. Another option it to punch holes in each side of the mask. Loop string through the holes to tie on the masks.
